RANKED IN THE TOP 25 FOR 2007

It has been confirmed that *“Madrid et le monde, les tourments d’une reconquête”*, published by Autrement as part of the CERI-Autrement collection, and written by Sylvia Desazars de Montgailhard (qualified Associate Professor and ESSEC Development Campaign Director) has been ranked in the top 25 books for 2007 by the Spanish edition of Foreign Policy, a reference amongst international political reviews.

Her publication comprises a wide-ranging and sharp analysis of Spanish foreign affairs policy and puts forward answers to key issues, including: Spanish foreign affairs policy in relation to the economic and democratic re-birth of the country; definition of Spanish policy decisions over the last 30 years; the factors that define modern Spain; and the status to which Spain aspires in international issues – a medium-sized major power or a medium-to-large power?

Sylvia Desazars de Montgailhard’s publication offers a lively account of Spanish policy, and features a plethora of one-off interviews with major figures from modern Spain, revealing the various motives, ambitions and dilemmas behind the return of Spain as a major power.
