

## **Permanent (tenured) position in Information Systems at ESSEC Business School**

The Department of Information Systems and Decision Sciences (SID) at ESSEC Business School invites applications for a full-time faculty position in information systems for September 2010.

ESSEC is a leading European business school, with two campuses in the Paris metropolitan area and a campus in Singapore. It offers mostly graduate level training in business administration (MBA, Executive MBA, Specialized Masters, Ph.D.). In 1997, it became the first AACSB accredited business school outside North America. The MBA program was ranked as number seven in the world in the 2007 Wall Street Journal ranking. To be considered, candidates should have a Ph.D. (or equivalent) in Information Systems, and show evidence of excellence both in research (publications in international IS journals) and in teaching.

Rank of appointment (Assistant/Associate/Full Professor) and salary will be commensurate with qualifications and experience. Candidates will be required to teach an MBA core course on IS and IT issues for managers (in French or English), though other courses are possible as well in the MBA and other programs (including Ph.D. and Specialized Masters program in IS). Ability to teach both in English and French is desirable, but not essential.

Interested candidates should send a letter of application along with curriculum vitae including a description of research and teaching activities, a complete list of publications, and the names and addresses of three referees. These documents should be sent (by email or by post) to:
