

Permanent Position in Statistics or Econometrics at ESSEC Business School

The Department of Information Systems and Decision Sciences at ESSEC Business School invites applications for a full-time faculty position (Associate/Full Professor) in Statistics or Econometrics.

ESSEC is a leading European business school (a French "Grande Ecole"), with two campuses, in the Paris metropolitan area and in Singapore. It offers mostly graduate level training in business administration (MBA, Executive MBA, Specialized Masters, PhD). In 1997, it became the first AACSB accredited business school outside North America. The MBA program was ranked seventh in the world by the Wall Street Journal in 2007 and its Master in Management fifth in Europe by the Financial Times over 2007-09. To be considered, candidates should hold a Ph.D. (or equivalent) in Statistics (e.g. Mathematical Statistics, Actuarial Science...) or in a field related to Econometric Theory (Econometrics, Finance...), and show evidence of excellence both in research and in teaching.

Support to research is key to ESSEC policy and faculty members enjoy a very favorable environment. Salaries are competitive on a European level.

Rank of appointment and salary will be commensurate with qualifications and experience. Candidates will have the opportunity to teach at MBA, Master or PhD levels.
