

GETTING TO ESSEC

By Car

From Paris take the "périphérique" (the beltway around Paris), then Highway A86 to Highway A15. Take Exit 9 off of Highway A15 . Turn left at the traffic light. Take the third left: "Avenue du Parc." ESSEC parking is on your left.

From the Airports

A taxi from Roissy - Charles de Gaulle or Orly airports to Cergy-Pontoise costs approximately: 60-80 Euros. The ride takes about 45 minutes from Roissy - Charles de Gaulle or an hour from Orly. To get to Paris by public transportation, Air France buses run from 5:50 a.m. to 11:10 p.m. every day. Then take RER Line A and follow directions below.

From Orly: Buses stop in Paris at Porte d'Orléans, Montparnasse and Invalides. Take the metro line to reach RER line A and follow directions below.

From Roissy - Charles de Gaulle: Buses stop at Porte Maillot and Charles de Gaulle Etoile. RER line B also runs from Roissy - Charles de Gaulle airport to central Paris.

By Public Transportation

By RER, from Paris stations at Etoile, Opera or Châtelet take RER Line A, direction Cergy. Get out at Cergy Préfecture. It is a five minute walk to ESSEC. Trains run from approximately 5:00 a.m. to 1:00 a.m. From the train station in Cergy Préfecture, go up the escalators, then walk towards the large, modern concrete building shaped like an inverted pyramid : the Préfecture. You will pass the BNP Bank and cinemas on your left. Continue around the left of the Préfecture. The ESSEC Campus is on the left of the park, just ahead of you.
